On 8 December 2014, our Superior General Fr Adolfo Nicolás convoked the 36th General Congregation (GC). The GC is being convoked for two reasons: Fr. Nicolás' resignation, which consequently requires the election of a new Superior General, and the regular need to consider contemporary developments of major importance and long lasting impact on the Society of Jesus and its service of the Church and of the world.

GC 36 will begin with the celebration of the Eucharist on 2 October 2016 at the General Curia in Rome. In the meantime, Fr. Nicolás invites us to prepare for GC 36 through a process of deep and genuine spiritual discernment about our life and mission, particularly now as the universal Church celebrates the Year of Consecrated Life.

In his "Apostolic Letter to All Consecrated People", Pope Francis expresses his hopes that religious might rediscover the joy of consecrated life, recover our prophetic witness that 'wakes up the world,' truly become 'experts in communion,' and go 'out of ourselves to the existential peripheries.' Fr. Nicolás reminds us that "this is the kind of deep discernment we as a Society are called to make."

The Constitutions of the Society [693] emphasize the importance of daily prayers offered for those going to the Congregation and for the matters that it will deal with "so that everything may turn out as may be for God's greater service, praise, and glory." Thus, we pray:
