Criteria/requirements for admission to the Graduate Diploma:

- An undergraduate degree or equivalent,
- Intermediate level of English,
- Age 21+ with demonstrated maturity,
- Relevant work experience,

Applicants will do a written test, have an interview and submit required references.



Enrolment commences on 20 August 2018 and will close once an adequate cohort is formed. Maximum 25 candidates per cohort.

The programme commences on 19 October 2018 and runs through to 06 September 2019. Quarters comprise 120 hours of contact time on every Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays for four hours each day and 60 hours of hands on experience/guided study on every Tuesdays and Thursdays. A certificate is granted on successful completion of each quarter. To those who complete all the four quarters, the graduate diploma will be awarded by the MLI in collaboration with Ateneo de Manila University.
